

Facebook Character Profiles

- ❖ Purpose: You will create a facebook page for a character from the novel to show your understanding of the character and the novel.
- ❖ Materials Needed: Posterboard, Markers, Pictures, Glue, Novel
- ❖ Brainstorming: You will work in groups to create this project
 1. Once in a group, you will be given a character in which you will create a profile.
 2. In your group you will brainstorm information of where the character lives, his/her age, place of birth, and school/occupation. In addition to the above mentioned topics, you will also make a list of the character's favorite/least favorite music, food, hobbies, activities, sports, colors, clothes, etc. Last you will make a list of friends, enemies, family, and co-workers.
 3. Part of this project will require quotes from the character and quotes from other characters about your character. Find quotes you think will benefit the profile.
- ❖ Creating the Profile: You will create the profile on posterboard.
 1. The name should be prominently on the poster along with a quote and page number that shows the "essence" of the character. This will be his/her status.
 2. On the wall of the profile, you will need at least six posts from other characters with at least three of these receiving a reply from your character. On the original posts, three of them should be direct quotes with page numbers from the novel. The others may be created by you, but they must pertain to the character's personality.
 3. On the front of the poster, list all the general information such as birthplace, occupation, age, where they live, etc. This will also be the side that contains the wall posts.
 4. On the back of the poster, list the favorites/least favorites, photos, and any other extras you would like to include.
- ❖ Grading: You will receive a group grade on the project. The posters will be graded by a rubric during the class presentations. The rubric is on the back of this page.
